## WHAT TO DO FOR FUN

**Moose Watching:** See the moose along Route 3 north of Pittsburg Village, east on RT 26 toward Errol and west from Canaan, VT toward Norton; all are common moose hangouts. Roadside mud or cars parked along the roadside at dawn or dusk are good indicators of a moose or two. Please use caution and bring a camera.

**Deer Watching:** Many people in the area feed the deer. The deer will feed very close to the roadside, creating that postcard-perfect herd for one to snap pictures. Halls Stream Rd. & River Rd., Pittsburg.

**Bird Watching:** 145-N for 9 miles, left onto West Rd. 1½ miles, left onto Moose Mtn. Rd. At this corner start following 6 wooden signs with green print - "TNC + an oak leaf" to an old boreal swamp with wooden walking paths.

**Magalloway Fire Tower:** Take a right off Rt. 3 between 1<sup>st</sup> and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Conn. Lakes in Pittsburg. Follow signs to bottom of hill. It's just a 40-minute hike before you can climb the fire tower and are able to take in four counties & breathtaking views.

**Beaver Brook Falls:** Located right on Rt. 145, no hiking needed, with a great little picnic area.

**Garfield Falls:** Magalloway Lookout Tower Road, 1.1 miles to wood bridge, 1/10 mile to a gray shingled camp, 1 mile to gated road. 6/10 mile to road on right, (DON'T TAKE IT) go 2.4 more miles to the Lookout Tower Road and pass it. Pass two camps on left; pass another road on right. Pass sand pits on both sides of road and pass another gated road on your left, pass another cottage on your right, then 1.2 miles to parking area. There is a trail on the left with small rocks defining it. (Total 12 miles.)

**Hiking:** Multiple trails can be found east of Colebrook on Rt. 26 in Dixville Notch including Table Rock & Sanguinary Ridge which offer spectacular views. Mt. Monadnock: Bridge St., Colebrook, follow to the end - take right at stop sign - 500' on left, park in gravel pit and follow signs to the trail. About a two-hour hike, allowing one to view two states. Magalloway Mountain and Deer Mountain, located in Pittsburg, are also easy hiking trails suited for the entire family. Cohos Trail: 162 miles of remote, wild and rugged hiking trail from the White Mountains to the Canadian Border.

**Fishing:** Many ponds, rivers and lakes can be found in the North Country, salmon and trout being the favorite catch of the day.

**Hunting:** This area offers some of the best grouse and woodcock hunting in the Northeast. Pheasants

are stocked by the Fish & Game Department in designated areas. The area is best known for large game hunting, such as white-tailed deer, black bear, and moose.

**Swimming:** Located in Colebrook is the North Country Recreation Indoor Pool off Route 3 at Lynch Road to 33 Rec Center Road. The Pool is open daily and offers a wide variety of activities. Many of our lakes and ponds also provide great access for swimming.

**Boating/Kayaking/Canoeing:** The Connecticut offers many places to paddle, with very few rapids, but there is a dam in West Stewartstown.

**Mountain Biking:** Great trails all over the North Country. Rt 3 from the Canadian border has great views, too.

**Snowmobiling:** This area offers the best snowmobiling around!!!

**Golf:** The Balsams offers an eighteen-hole championship course. Donald Ross designed the Panoramic course. The Colebrook Country Club offers a nine-hole par 36 course.

**Tennis:** The tennis courts in the center of Pittsburg and Canaan are for public use.

**Fall Foliage:** Our foliage starts in September peaking mid to late September.

**Balsams Wilderness:** Exceptional skiing at affordable prices and no lines. Alpine and many cross-country trails.

**Cemeteries:** Off Rt. 145 south of Pittsburg is the Grave of **Metallak** the 120-year-old Indian. Each town also has a number of old cemeteries.

**Colebrook Historical Society:** Situated in Colebrook's Town Hall on Bridge St., this small museum offers one the taste of Colebrook's yesteryears. Open 10-2 every Saturday, June-Aug.

**Pittsburg Historical Society:** Situated in the old Town Hall (across from the Police Station), this museum is filled with memories of Pittsburg's past. Hours vary and are posted.

**Canaan Historical Society:** Situated upstairs in an old historical building, The Alice Ward Memorial Library. Open year round call 802-266-7135 for hours open.

**Shrine of Our Lady of Grace:** On Rt. 3 one mile south of Colebrook, beautiful 15 acre shrine maintained by the Oblate Fathers. Gift shop on premises. Open May-October.

**Haynes Homestead:** East Colebrook, pick your own berries and vegetables.

**Poore Family Homestead:** Located on Rt. 145, this historical farm turned museum is an incredible journey back in time. Farm established in 1826, open summers.

## CANADA

**Le Parc de la GORGE:** Open May to Oct., for reservations call (819) 849-2331. Includes the Trolley Center, mineralogical & botanical booth, hydroelectric power plant, abandoned island, suspension bridge, beet factory, Couillard's Tower, The Cave, Belmont Water Co., the Red Covered Bridge; tubing adds to the winter fun & much more. Be sure to take one of Coaticook Regions "Photo Album Tours" as they have prepared 6 different ones for your enjoyment. Stops that are a must: Trout Farm in East Hereford (Rte. 253), St. Malo's Church and Tower (Rte. 253), Compton's Family Farm (Vaillancourt Road), Baldwin Mills Parc Decouverte Nature (Baldwin-Barnston Road).

**Magnetic Hill:** Rt. 3 north of Pittsburg, first hill just past the Canadian border. (*YOU* explain it.)

**Mt. Megantic Observatory:** Approx. 25 miles from Pittsburg border, Rt. 3 to 257 & 212 in Quebec. Quebec students study the stars and planets here. Visitors welcome July 1<sup>st</sup> - Labor day.

**Lac Megantic:** Rt. 3 to 257, 212E and 161N in Quebec to get to the Village of Lac Megantic. 30 mile Lake with excursions on their passenger boat, Captain Cap.

**Panoramic View:** 1,000 feet north of Pittsburg border crossing. Views resembling those in National Geographic Magazines. Also a large cross (illuminated at night) and a nice picnic area.

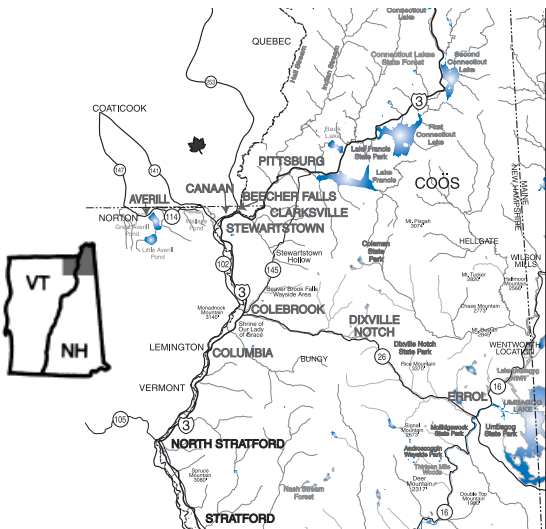
**Granby Zoo:** Located in Granby, Quebec a large zoo with many exhibits, rides and a water park - Amazoo.
